Conditions of Entry:

Medical arm bands and Current Riding helmets do not need NOT need to be presented upon collection of back number prior to riding dressage BUT PCAV cards must be presented. Parents / guardians/ riders must ensure that riders wear current helmets and armbands as per PCAV rules. **OPEN riders** are required to wear medical armbands for all phases also.

All competitors in the OPEN are required to fill in all pages of day attendance form before they can ride

Entrants must provide name of a helper for Cross Country Jump judges to assist on the day (**ALL PONY CLUBS** are required to provide **1 jump judge to every 3 entries.**

This is vital for the successful running of the event.

Jump Judges briefing to start at 11.30am. Please bring a chair or car and sunscreen and hat. Lunch packs provided.

Please Note the following conditions must be adhered to by competitor and their associates.

Conditions of Entry: Entry is conditional upon acceptance of these conditions.

1. Entry Fee is as per schedule per entry.
2. **Open Riders**
 - a. Everybody fills in the [Liability Declaration Form](#)
 - b. \$10 Day Attendance Fee is due UNLESS you are a financial member* of EV/EA; AHS; SHCA; AERA; an Interstate Pony Club; or can prove personal Liability Cover of at least \$10,000,000. ***Must** produce proof.
 - c. Riders without adequate Insurance Cover pay \$10 for Liability Only cover for the duration of the event. (Not personal Medical) and complete the [Day Participant Waiver](#).
 - d. PCAV club member cards must be inspected at the secretary's office.
PCAV Insurance Policy specifically states anyone not following PCAV Rules may be left uninsured.
3. All refunds will incur a \$10 administration fee. There will be no refunds after the closing date unless the event secretary for the event has been notified prior to ride time and a valid veterinary or doctor's medical certificate is supplied to the event secretary within 7 days of notification of scratching.
4. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCAV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
5. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
6. Competitors may ride more than one horse, subject to the conditions of PCAV *Handbook of By-laws* multiple horse rules.
7. Complying helmets Must worn, spot checks may occur.
8. Gear Check: required for all riders before each phase.
9. Medical Armbands: must be worn by all competitors.
10. Riders under eight years of age may not compete, horses must be at least age four, no stallions, colts or rigs.
11. Competitor numbers - the organising committee will pre-allocate and advise numbers. Competitors may supply their own numbers. However, body numbers must be used for cross-country. Body numbers will be available at the event.
12. PCAV Alcohol Policy applies.
13. **Dogs are prohibited without exception.**
14. Queries, protests, horse abuse, rules as per the PCAV *Handbook of By-Laws*.
15. PCAV Lungeing Policy applies.
16. Neither the organising committee of this competition nor the PCAV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
